## System of Play:

9 ball according to official WPA and EPBF Rules
128 participants (of which 28 entries remain as organiser's Wild Cards)
I stage: Double KO – race to 7.
II stage (32 players / qualifiers): Single KO – race to 9.

## Participation / Entries and confirmation of enrollment:

Entry fee: 25 Euro

Entries (First name, Surname, E-mail address) should be sent by e-mail to: marioroter@op.pl until 05.11.2011 the latest.

You will receive a return E-mail with the entry fee payment details.

After the payment has been made you should send the confirmation of this fact back to the Organiser to the e-mail given above.

Only upon the confirmation of the payment the Entry is valid and the name will be put on the Participants List on the Organisers Website (<u>www.mario-bilard.pl</u>).

## Draw:

Draw will be concluded on the 08.11.2010 (Tuesday) around 19.00. It will not be possible to make any additional Entry after the Draw has been made (even if there are still empty spots in the FlowChart).

## **Dress Code:**

For this Tournament the smart, official dress code is obligatory, with special additional requirements as follows:

- plain colour shirt long or short sleeved (no patterns stripes, dots, etc.)
- waist-coat and a bowtie (or a tie)
- only black colour, formal style trousers (ironed into a crease)
- only black colour, formal, leather (or leather look like) shoes

Trousers **MUST** be good fashioned formal style, with a crease pressed into. No jeans, denim, no jeans cut, no patterns, no light seams or stitches. no studs or similar decorations, etc. The Tournament Director has the final judgement with regards to the legality of participant's attire and is permitted to disqualify the player on the grounds of Dress Code violation.

## **Additional Regulations:**

Player must be present at the Venue at least 15 minutes before his scheduled match time and must be prepared for the commencement of the match (full attire) at least 10 minutes before his scheduled match time.

In case the Player is not fully prepared for his match 5 minutes after the scheduled match time he will automatically lose the respective match by forfeit.

During the duration of Tournament the designated "playing arena" will be restricted only to Players who's matches are in progress at the time; no other persons have the right to remain there.

Drinking alcohol is strictly forbidden for players until they finished playing their matches for the day.

All participants are obliged to obey to Rules, to advice from Tournament Officials; also to remain sportsmanlike, especially to behave accordingly to sports competition regulations as not to disturb other players.

Participants and spectators not obeying to these requirements will be asked to leave the venue. Participants misbehaviour may be subject to disqualification from the Tournament and to Disciplinary Report to respective organisation.
